



Registration Process

Step 1. https://parivesh.nic.in in the address bars of the web browser i.e. Google Chrome etc. and press Enter. A Home page of PARIVESH portal will appear



- Step 3. By simply clicking on the "Registration" option, you will be directed to the Registration page.
- Step 4. Register As a "Project Proponent/User Agency"
- Step 5. Complete the process with submission of Basic Details etc. PAN is Mandatory.

Demand Note

- Payment for NPV, CA, Wildlife Management Plan (WLMP), Soil & Moisture Conservation Plan (SMCP) will be deposited online in CAMPA Account only.
- In case of delay in preparation of plan, lump sum amount of 2% and 0.5% of project cost against WLMP & SMCP respectively may be proposed.
- Payment for Tree felling & Boundary demarcation will be paid on **WBSFDA**Account only.
- Payment Should be made on **individually** project wise only.

Stage-I Compliance Conditions

- The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated.
- The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintenance of the compensatory afforestation.
- The State Government shall charge the **Net Present Value (NPV)**.
- A Wildlife Management Plan shall be prepared, and implemented.
- The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be submitted
- The non-forest land transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department and shall be **notified** by the State Government.

Stage-I Compliance Conditions...contd.

- Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
- The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval
- All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only.
- Wherever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake appropriate afforestation.
- The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if applicable

Stage-I Compliance Conditions...contd.


- No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- The dumping area for muck disposal shall be stabilized and reclaimed.
- The User Agency shall implement the R & R Plan, if applicable.
- The User Agency shall submit the annual self -compliance report by the end of March every year regularly.

For Processeing of Final Approval

On receipt of the In-Principle approval, DFO raise the Demand Note through online portal. UA makes payment & hands over CA land to DFO (if applicable) and submit the compliance report (CR)

After examination CF/CCF recommends the compliance report to Nodal Officer

SG forward the CR to RO/CG for according the FINAL APPROVAL



With **approval of NO**, DFO, place the Demand Note to UA for payment and other compliance



After examination DFO recommend the compliance report to CF/CCF for final approval



After examination and approval of PCCF, NO forward the complaince report to SG

Re-opening/Re-consideration of proposals (1.13 of Adhiniyam)

- > Proposals, where essential detail/information sought by the processing authorities, is delayed by the user agency for a period of more than 90 days, shall be de-listed automatically from the PARIVESH portal..
- > The user agency, after having addressed the concerns of the processing authorities, may submit an online request for re-listing of the proposal to the Nodal Officer in the State or the Inspector General of Forest (Forest Conservation) in the Central Government, DDG (Central) in the Regional Office, as the case may be.
